All individual authorities issues by Sydney Metropolitan Wildlife Services Inc. under this licence expire on 30th June annually.

By submitting the membership renewal application to apply for an Authority to Rescue, Rehabilitate and Release Native Wildlife, you agree to the terms and conditions of Sydney Metropolitan Wildlife Services Inc. which include, but are not limited to:

- Abide by the Constitution and Policies of Sydney Metropolitan Wildlife Services Inc. and work within the bounds of the organisations objectives and aims; and
- Comply with directions and conditions placed upon Sydney Metropolitan Wildlife Services Inc. and its members by the NSW National Parks and Wildlife Service, in association with OEH, and work within wildlife and animal cruelty laws at all times;
- Maintain all necessary animal and personal records as set out in the Policies of the Incorporation; and
- Operate and comply within the Incorporations policies regarding animal registration, movements, housing, care and release; and
- Pay an annual authorisation renewal fee of \$30; and
- Participate in the functioning of the Incorporation and the promotion of its objectives; and
- Assist in other duties, from time to time, as required by the organisation; and
- Agree to allow people authorised by the Board of Sydney Wildlife access to your facilities for wildlife care: either advice on facility set-up or animal care; or to check on the status of Sydney Wildlife animals in care.
- Any material / photos etc provided and/or developed during the execution of Sydney Wildlife's function shall be given freely and become Sydney Wildife's IP.
- Work a minimum of two (2) shifts in the office per annum.
- Register all animal rescues that are not coordinated through the Office (obtain animal record number) within 48 hours.
- Report to your Branch Species Coordinator all animals taken into care within 48 hours and comply with directions from Coordinators regarding animal care.

Please note: that with the exception of species requiring specific training (eg. snakes, bats, macropods, raptors) members are expected to rescue all species whether they will foster the animal or not.
